



## **AGM and visit to The London Archaeological Archive and Research Centre (LAARC)**

**Friday 21 September 2012**

The **AGM** will be held at **The LAARC**, Mortimer Wheeler House, 46 Eagle Wharf Road, London, N1 7ED, **commencing at 4.30pm.**

The meeting will be preceded by a **guided tour of The LAARC**, commencing at 3pm.

The LAARC became the main store and archaeological hub of the Museum of London in 1992.

Based at Mortimer Wheeler House in Hackney, the LAARC holds information concerning nearly 8,500 archaeological sites that have been investigated in Greater London over the past 100 years.

In addition, the LAARC stores the full archives for over 3,500 of these sites as the records and finds from nearly all archaeological work in London come here.

The LAARC is the primary source of evidence of early London and a resource of international significance. Because of the richness of the material and the historical importance of London, it continues to make an essential contribution to studies of the Roman Empire, of prehistoric and medieval Europe, and of early modern colonialism.

Duration of the tour is 1½ hours, and will conclude at 4.30pm, to be followed by the AGM.

Following the tour an **optional informal dinner** will be arranged, details including cost will be provided to those who register for the dinner.

Members are welcome to bring guests.

Prior registration is necessary for the tour and restaurant, as numbers attending are required.

There is no charge for members who wish to only attend the AGM.
