INTRODUCTION

Masonry has a proven track record as a durable, low maintenance, sustainable construction material for a variety of civil engineering and building applications, both structural and non-structural. In spite of this, it appears that growing numbers of construction professionals seem to be unaware of the potential benefits that masonry has to offer the construction industry. Masonry therefore needs to “*stand up and be counted!*”
